Family Promise of Montgomery has plans to open a new program that will be a Family Nutrition Education Program. The purpose of this program is to serve as a vessel to teach low-income families how to prepare healthy meals on a budget they can afford.

Briefly describe your plans for administration of this project or program request? \*

The cottage at the new Family Promise of Montgomery location is already gutted and ready to be transformed. The plans for the cottage will be for it to become an office space and alternative case management facility. While remodeling the cottage, we will transform the kitchen space into a small, but functional commercial kitchen. We have already started working with a Nutritionist and a Chef to prepare menus, cookbooks and training for the guests in our program. We will also plant a vegetable and herb garden in the courtyard that will serve as a stress-free case management area while providing new skills and a deeper understanding of how we can all grow with the planting of a small seed.

How will you evaluate the success of this project or program? Or how have you evaluated the success of this project or program in the past?

This program will reduce nutrition insecurity of low-income families and youth in our community. We will follow-up with graduates of our program and connect them to the Wellness Coalition to follow their progress after completing our program. This portion of Family Promise will have the ability to improve diets, improve nutrition practices, help families stretch their food dollars further, handle food more safely and increase their physical activity levels.
